"By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh," (Hebrews 11:4).

CHURCH SPOTLIGHT

Refuge City Church Cedar Rapids, IA

Over the past five years, Refuge City Church has faced storm after storm. COVID closures, a derecho that destroyed their building, financial hardship, and multiple moves left the congregation praying for stability. In January 2025, they welcomed a new pastor, Brother Aaron Amundson—but weeks later, their landlord issued an eviction notice.

With just 30 days to move, Pastor Aaron and his wife, Laura, laid the notice before the Lord in prayer. God intervened, granting them an extension until June 30. Soon after, they learned of a downtown facility for sale. With help from the UPCI Church Loan Fund, financial provision, and even a \$55,000 price reduction, the church closed on their new building just two weeks before their deadline.

Through it all, revival has continued—five baptized in Jesus' name and six filled with the Holy Ghost this summer alone. Like Isaac, they can declare, *"The Lord hath made room for us, and we shall be fruitful in the land."*
